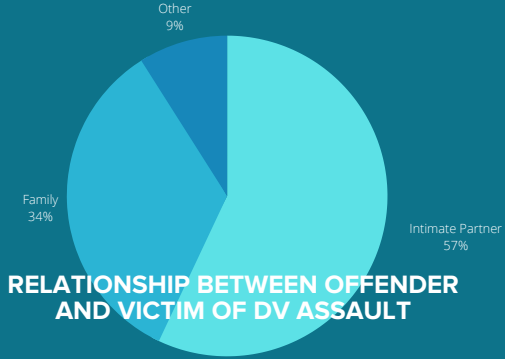


The needs of our region
